

What This Is

Pre-Separation Training is a **preventive, upstream training system** that prepares service members — and their families — for life after the military **before separation occurs**.

The system is built around a simple reality: **The service member is the common denominator of the transition system**.

When individuals leave the military without clear operating context, that confusion follows them into every environment that comes next.

Pre-Separation Training stabilizes that context early, so individuals are better prepared wherever they go.

Who This Is For

Organizations that support service members **before separation**, including:

- Veteran-serving nonprofits
- Workforce programs
- Guard and Reserve commands
- Institutional partners

Why Organizations Engage

Most legacy transition efforts operate **downstream**, after confusion has already compounded.

Pre-Separation Training is used as an **upstream readiness foundation** inside workforce or grant-funded initiatives. This helps downstream services work better by aligning individuals **before** placement or employment.

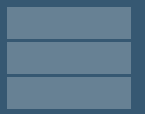
Guard & Reserve Use

Commands use the system to create consistency when access to transition resources varies. This reduces uncertainty for service members and strain on leadership.

How This Complements Existing Services
